KS 2026-194 — Open Letter to the Municipal Council of Mönsterås

Dear Maria,

And to all 48 other highly esteemed members of the Municipal Council of Mönsterås (as well as, of course, the press, friends, and all citizens of Mönsterås, Örebro, and anyone else who serves or lives under the blue and yellow banner) — who, as early as Monday the 11th of May at 10:01 AM, were already informed in digital format of the active cover-up that the Municipality of Mönsterås is conducting with the full knowledge and blessing of its highest leadership, on both the political and the administrative side.

This active culture of silence being maintained in Mönsterås is not merely a flagrant violation of legal rights that affects my son (out of respect for his integrity, psychosocial wellbeing and current situation, I respectfully ask the media — unlike the principal authority's representatives — to keep him anonymous) — it is an assault on and outright sabotage of democracy, freedom, civil rights, and our constitution.

From December 20th of last year, it took 37 days — until January 26, 2026 — to obtain classified email logs from Sara Brogård, principal of Parkskolan — redacted by said Sara Brogård in her own illustrious civil servant capacity. As someone who has actually stood outside the 70-km/h signs, tapped Zlatan Ibrahimovic on the shoulder, interviewed Mikael Stahre after he took a golf ball to the head in Hällevik, and arranged a tram for Joel Lundqvist, I find this somewhat peculiar.

Fortunately for you, Maria, it was also a committee other than Culture and Leisure that tried to dodge me in a separate matter concerning an illegal body search under Police Act §19, carried out by one of Parkskolan's teachers in my son's locker on November 28, 2025. I eventually received a "general response" and a referral back to Principal Brogård — who would have made SJ and Banverket green with envy back in the cheerful 1980s. "A cancelled gig is still a gig," said Ulf Gerhard Lundell during a particularly bleak stretch. "No search took place, therefore no documentation was made," Brogård countered in the year 2026.

Since then, my son has been in legal limbo. He has been served notice of criminal suspicion, but now, nearly five months to the day after the incident in question, he has still not even been interviewed. The principal authority's handling of this specific matter could fill an entire novel — and that is precisely what I am in the process of writing. KS 2026-194 is, as mentioned, the case reference number that you and the other members of the full council have been notified of since Thursday last week, May 8th, at 10:00 AM.

On March 28th, I requested a series of public documents relating to my son, following all the rules and conventions of the principle of public access. The following week I submitted a new request concerning metadata logs and data from the email accounts belonging to Principal Sara Brogård, Municipal Council Chair Anders Johansson, and Municipal Secretary Karin Dahlin. Today is May 14th, and the Municipality of Mönsterås has still — two weeks later — not provided a single legal basis for its refusal to release the documents in the requested digital format. Instead, they continue to obstruct, attempt to palm off hard copies, and cite "routines" and rulings that have no bearing whatsoever on the case at hand. That particular matter is

now before the Administrative Court of Appeal in Jönköping.

I ask you to take particular note of the European Court of Justice ruling in case C-797/23, between Meta Platforms Ireland and the Italian communications authority AGCOM, which was handed down yesterday. It is available in full on Curia; SPCMO also has a useful summary. The ruling concerns the right of access to documents in their original format.

The hard copies I received from Principal Brogård back in January were, in fact, genuinely incriminating — but that is a separate legal process from the one hanging over my beloved son, and one that will in all likelihood be pursued by the Parliamentary Ombudsman, the Chancellor of Justice, and the Schools Inspectorate — but above all by our elected representatives, families, parents, and children. When justice has run its course and history has had its say, I reckon I'll still have enough convictions for malfeasance in office and criminal judgements to keep me warm through the winter.

**This circus is over. Now the money-changers are being driven from the temple!**
